




SECTION 5. 305.18 (3)(a)
ORDINANCE
RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES
ON HIGHWAYS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF ACCESS
No. 97-01

The town board of the Town of Ellington, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The Township will allow the operation of snowmobiles on a roadway and shoulder of a highway for any portion of a highway that lies within the boundaries of the Town for the purpose of residential access.

SECTION 2: Definition - Section 3. 350.01 (10m) "Purpose of residential access" means for the purpose of traveling for the shortest distance that is necessary for a person operating the snowmobile to go between a residence and the snowmobile route or snowmobile trail that is closest to that residence.


